Indigenous Student Trustee Westlake provided an update from the Ontario Student Trustees' Association - l'Association des élèves conseillers et conseillères de l'Ontario (OSTA-AECO) conference. The TVDSB Indigenous portfolio presented Indigenous Student Trustee Westlake with the medallion.

It was noted that the medallion for Indigenous Student Trustees to wear to meetings and functions was created using the Indigenous Portfolio logo which was designed by a former student.

a. Indigenous Education Portfolio Update

Administration provided an Indigenous Education Portfolio update highlighting activities and events.

b. Board Action Plan (BAP) Update

Administration indicated that the Indigenous Education Portfolio will be meeting with the Education Officer from the Ministry of Education the week of November 25 to review last year's Board Action Plan (BAP).

Superintendent Auckland provided an update on Jordan's Principle noting there were minimal requests between 2024 October and November.

Questions of clarification were addressed by Administration regarding funding for Jordan's Principle.

Administration provided clarification on the request for Education Assistant (EAs) support, and the process for parents/families to request Jordan's Principle funding to support students.

a. Chippewas of the Thames First Nation

Committee member Styers provided an update noting a new principal was hired in 2024 September, the hiring of two Knowledge Keepers, sweat lodges have been installed on playgrounds, extra-curricular activities are being planned, the formation of a theatre group, community and parent engagement events were well attended, and upcoming discussions regarding the Education Services Agreement.

b. Munsee-Delaware Nation

Committee member Correia provided an update noting students are attending Delaware Central Public School, and ongoing monthly meetings with Administration from Strathroy District Collegiate Institute.

c. Oneida Nation of the Thames

Committee member Summers provided an update noting the planning of the 50th anniversary of the building of the elementary school, the approval of a new elementary school build, capital projects within the community, a holiday pageant, literacy and numeracy professional development sessions and training for staff, the vacant Intermediate Student Advocate position, and the Education Services Agreement.
